Grades 1-6: August 10-14th 8:30-5pm

Due to our current circumstances with COVID-19, and in attempt to keep our school community socially distanced, we are going to run our Annual Before School Open House different from we have in the past. Rather than having the school open for an hour one night, we will have the building open the week of August 10th-14th from 8:30-5:00PM. During this time, parents in grades 1st – 6th grade may stop by to grab their parent packet, pay for lunches and other school fees, and students will be able to see their classroom, desk and locker/hook, as well as leave their school supplies by their desk.

Kindergarten: August 11th 6-7pm

Having the school year end the way it did, did not allow our incoming Kindergarten class to participate in their Transition days for entering Kindergarten. Therefore, we will have a Transition/Open House night for the incoming Kindergarten class on August 11th. We will meet in the gym at the elementary school and will have Introductions to new classmates, tour the school, playground, put school supplies away, and give each parent an opportunity to take a “First Day of School” picture. We ask that kindergarten parents do not come into the building the first day of school. Parents will also get their school packet, and will have a chance to pay for lunches.

Pre-School: Corsica Campus: August 11th 5-7pm. Stickney Campus: August 12th 5-7 pm.

Having the school year end the way it did, did not allow our incoming Pre-school class to participate in their transition days for entering Pre-school. Therefore, we will have a Transition/Open House night for the incoming Pre-School class on August 11th and 12th. Open house at the Pre-school in Corsica will be on August 11th from 5:00 until 7:00pm. Parents may bring in their student to meet the teacher, see their classroom, receive any school information they will need, and drop off school supplies.
