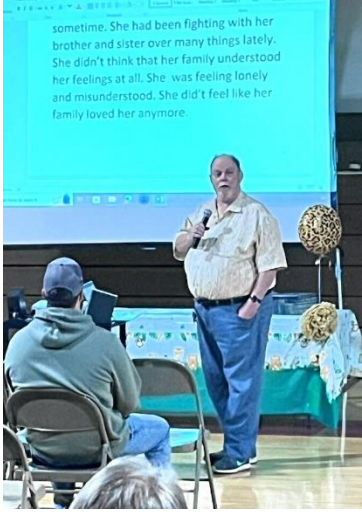
Top Superiors from State meeting

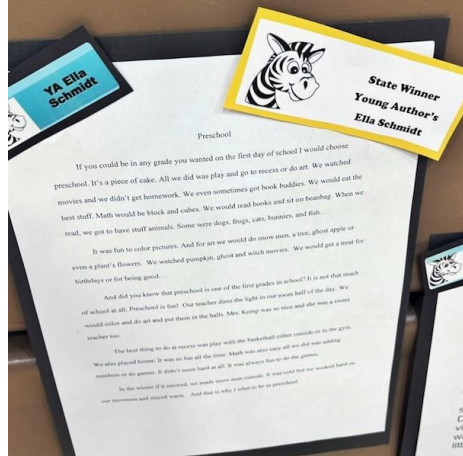
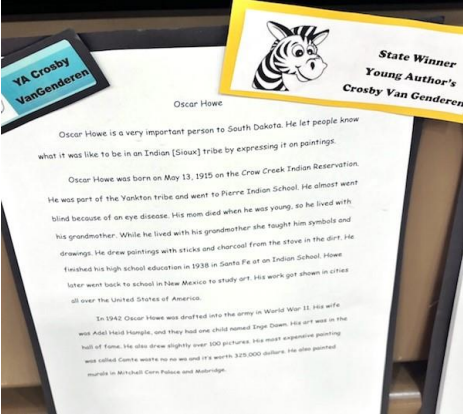
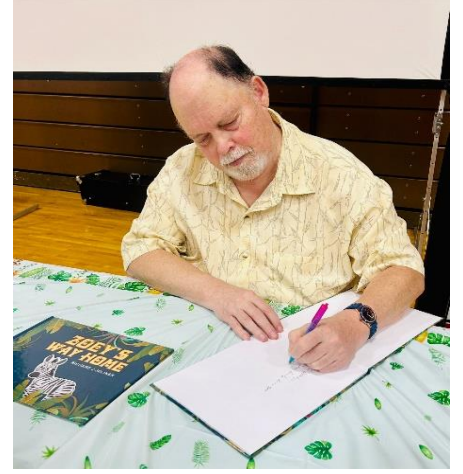




Lewis & Clark Literacy Awards
