Welcome to the 2026-2027 School Year!!

We encourage everyone to check it frequently to keep up-to-date on all the activities and on any changes that occur along the way. The website will be kept as current as possible as we keep refining it and adding new items.

Supplies list: A copy of this year's school supply list is available on the school website's home page or available in either office.

Notice: the school buildings at both campuses will be open at **7:45 AM** for students.

Please **DO NOT** drop off students before this time as we do not have staff available to supervise.

On days we have a **10am start**, breakfast *will not* be served and the shuttle buses will leave from their respective towns at 9:30am. School buildings will open at 9:15am...**please do NOT send/drop off students before that time.**

First Day of School is Tuesday, August 18th. Full Day--8:35 AM to 3:35 PM.

Breakfast will be served from 7:45 to 8:20 AM. Corsica/Stickney bus students will eat breakfast before leaving to school site. The morning student transport bus to will leave at **8:10 AM Sharp** from each town. Note any student wanting breakfast---Serving will end at 8:20 AM. The PM shuttle will leave Corsica at **3:10pm** and go to Stickney, arriving approximately **3:25pm**. The shuttle will return with students arriving in Corsica approximately **3:40pm**.

Meal prices for the 2026-27 school year:

Breakfast Prices: K-12th = **\$2.20** (20 meals=\$44.00)

Lunch Prices: K-5th = **\$3.25** (20 meals =\$65), 6th-12th = **\$3.65** (20 meals=\$73.00)

Adult Prices: Breakfast=\$2.70 each / Lunch=\$5.35 each

The Free/Reduced Meal form is on the website. Please fill out and return to either office ASAP.

You may pay for students at both campuses with one check, just write a note of who/how many meals you are paying for.

Parents/Students we would like to welcome everyone back for the 1st day of school planned for Tuesday, August 18, 2026.

Since the Corsica-Stickney School District was organized for the 2015-16 school year it was one of the goals to update our facilities. This summer in Stickney, the elementary gym along with the foyer to the east received a new roof part of a facility plan that has been continuous to improve and keep facilities up to date.

New this year a Farm to School Food Program that will feature locally grown and processed beef donated from local producers in our school lunch program. We are very excited for this and thankful for the contributions our participating producers and processing donors gave us.

Corsica-Stickney School provides many on-site course offerings as well as Dual credit course opportunities for students that qualify. This allows students to begin their post-secondary careers at a reduced tuition price for qualifying classes. Corsica-Stickney graduates continue to garner many scholarships towards their post-secondary education supported by many local individuals and organizations. We believe student academic accomplishments are a direct result of excellent educational opportunities offered at Corsica-Stickney School, excellent staff, supportive parents and a supportive educational community.

Corsica-Stickney School continues to host an additional educational program (located in the Elementary Building in Corsica) operated by the Core Educational Cooperative that serves special needs students ages 18-21 in continuing their education.

The staff for the Corsica-Stickney School District aspire for an educational environment that is focused on the student's welfare for developing the intellectual, social, physical, and vocational potential of each student. Corsica-Stickney School attempts to provide students with many educational experiences. You will see a number of new staff in the business program, industrial tech, guidance, 1st grade, and math areas this year as some of our past staff have moved on or retired. We were fortunate to find quality instructors to replace our former staff members.

The societal and educational pressures the public educational system addresses continues to be more challenging and more complex today. Yes, the system has changed over years, but the public education system in Corsica-Stickney delivers educational curriculum and opportunity that is excellent for all students in our rural area.

One last item, I would like to encourage students who might want to be teachers to visit with me as there are several opportunities and pathways to get a teaching certificate. Rural schools need to have teachers in the future, and I would like to encourage students to check out becoming a teacher---

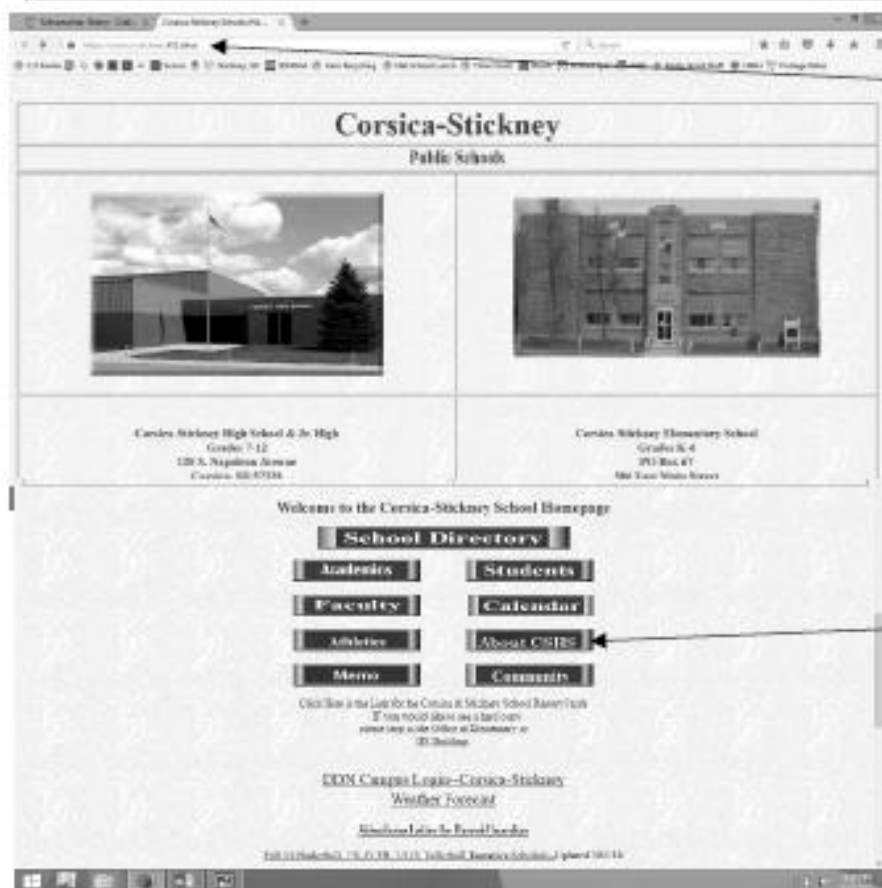

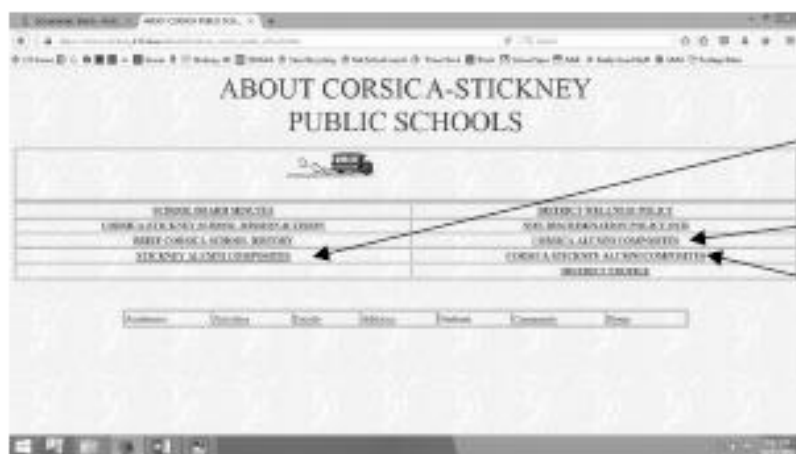

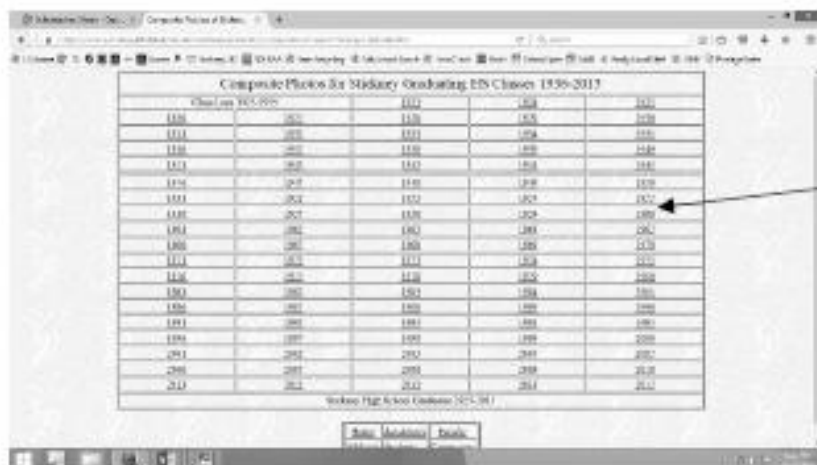
