## Four vocalists selected for All-State Chorus

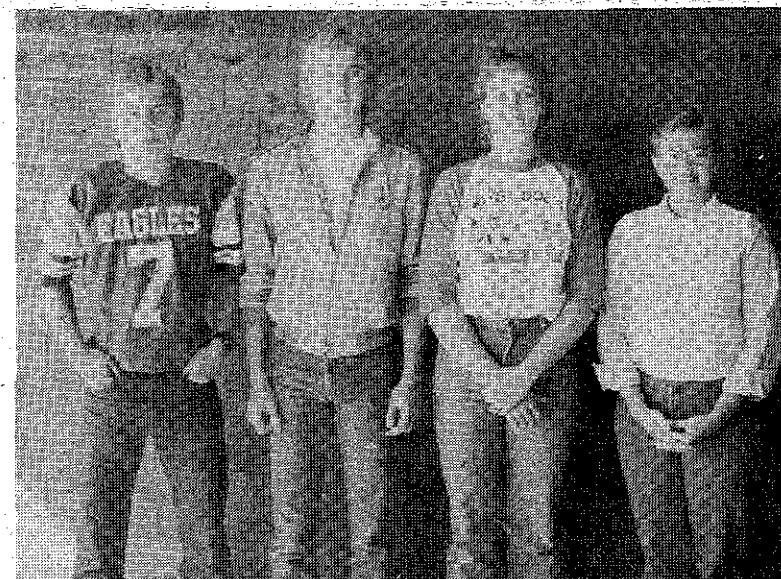
Selections were made for All-State from a field of 16 competitors.
