Grade School Comets take first in tournament

The Comets made their way to the championship game by defeating Armour in the first round by the score of 23-17. Leading scorers for both teams were Wade Bamberg with six points for Corsica and Jim Altenberg with nine points for Armour. Stickney also advanced to the championship game by beating New Holland.

appeared to be a Cadet blow away, when a shocking second half comeback by Armour kept the game close. New Holland held on to take 3rd place.

The championship game between Corsica and Stickney was close but Corsica managed to hold on to a slim lead and won the championship by the score 36-31. Leading scorers for both teams were Jason Evans and Ed Kuil for Corsica with 10 points apiece, and for Stickney Ken Redeker with 16 points.

The Comets coach, Aren Kuyper, said that he was pleased with the team effort and was proud of his boys. The season ended with a record of six wins and six losses.

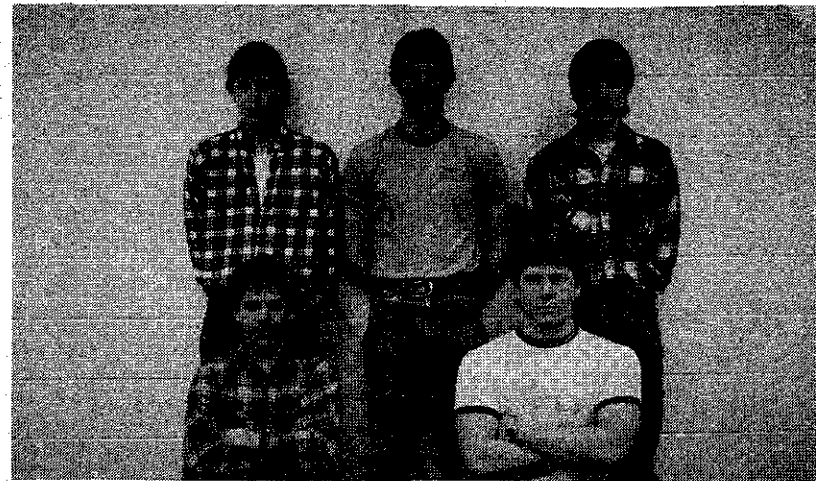

Comets end with 11-8 season

The Corsica Comets had a good season finishing 11-8 and tied for 3rd in the conference with a 5-3 record. The Comets averaged 50.7 points per game and 35.7 rebounds. The opponents averaged 44.3 points per game.

Corsica shot 41.2% from the field and 56% from the free throw line. The Comets were led by Troy Bosma who shot 67% FT and 45% FG, scored 263 points, and had 201 rebounds. Bosma also made 2nd team All-Conference. Jeff Buntrock, who shot 63% FT, scored 197 points and had 96 rebounds, Scott Menning who shot 43% FG, scored 149 points and had 99 rebounds, Dale Uttecht, who shot 73% FT, had 127 points, and 135 rebounds. Uttecht also made third team All-Conference.
